A Bill Intituled

AN ACT for the Abolition of Distress for Rent. Title.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- The Short Title of this Act is "The Distress for Rent Short Title. Abolition Act, 1893." It shall commence

- and come into force from and after the last day of the now current year.
- It shall not be lawful for any person hereafter to distrain Distress for rent abolished. 10 for rent or arrears of rent; and no landlord shall be entitled to any preferential claim for payment of rent in the event of the bankruptcy of his tenant.
 - From and after the commencement of this Act the several Imperial and colonial Acts repealed. Acts and parts of Acts of Parliament in the Schedule first enumerated 15 shall cease to have force in the colony, and the Acts and part of an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand in the Schedule secondly enumerated shall be repealed.

11 Geo. II., c. 19 (1738.) ... An Act for the more effectual securing the Payment of Rents, and preventing Frauds by Tenants.

14 & 15 Vict., c 25 (1851.) ... An Act to improve the Law of Landlord and Tenant in relation to Emblements, and to Growing Crops seized in Execution, and to Agricultural Tenants' Fixtures. *In part—namely*, sections two and four.
