A Bill IntituledAN ACT to amend "The Native Grantees Act, 1873." Title.

Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Preamble. Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Native Grantees Act Short Title. 1873 Amendment Act, 1876."
- Nothing contained in "The Native Grantees Act, 1873," shall be Saving Clause. construed to affect or to invalidate any deed or instrument which before and but for the coming into force of the said Act was valid at law and in equity; but every such deed and instrument shall continue to have the same validity and operation, and to be as binding on the parties thereto, as if the said Act had not been passed.
